## PLAY AREAS:

### JUBILEE FIELD, UPTON CROSS AND PARSONS MEADOW RILLA MILL

Both Jubilee Field at Upton Cross and the play area in Parsons Meadow at Rilla Mill have been re-opened after a covid-19 based risk assessment was undertaken. All the play equipment within the play area at Parsons Meadow is open. In Jubilee field the tunnel has been closed, the gate has been removed on the under 5's play area and the benches have been moved apart so that social distancing can be achieved safely. Regular safety checks on both play areas have resumed and signage to guide users is in place.

Whilst the Covid-19 alert level remains in place, users of the play areas should observe the following requirements, to help minimise the risks of transmission. **You are responsible for the safety of your family and other families using the play equipment.**

- X** Please do not enter the play areas if you, or anyone in your household are showing symptoms, or are self-isolating
- ✓** All visitors should sanitise their hands before entering the play area, and again on leaving. If you cannot sanitise your children's hands please **do not allow** your children to use the play equipment.
- X** Please do not enter if the play area appears busy, and avoid equipment if already occupied
- ✓** Children should be supervised carefully to maintain good hygiene and to ensure children wait their turn to use equipment where it is safe to do so
- X** If possible ensure that all visitors avoid shouting, touching faces or mouths and observe social distancing rules from anyone outside of their household or support bubble
- X** Do not eat food or smoke in the play area
- X** Please remember that the Covid-19 virus can survive longer on internal hard surfaces, so if possible entering play tunnels or small playhouses should be avoided.
- ✓** Please take all of your PPE and litter home with you.
