

Linkinhorne Parish Council

Due to the meeting on the 26th July 2021 being inquorate the Parish Council were unable to conduct any formal business. An informal meeting of the Parish Council took place to discuss matters on the agenda allowing Councillors to express a view with the Councillors referred to the Clerk in accordance with the emergency scheme of delegation.

Anyone interested in making a difference to the community is welcome to apply to become a Councillor. Your help is essential in maintaining the well-used community assets such as the play areas, public conveniences, burial ground, footpaths, allotments etc.

At the meeting the Council informally discussed the following application with the decision confirmed via the scheme of delegation:

- i) PA21/05690. Uphill House Rilla Mill Proposed rear and side extension to existing house. Linkinhorne parish Council does not object to the application. This response represents the opinion of members of Linkinhorne Parish Council identified through a consultation process as per the Council emergency scheme of delegation and will be ratified at the next appropriate meeting of the council.
- ii) Linkinhorne Parish Council requests that a site meeting by the Local Planning Authority is undertaken to establish the sensitivity of the site within the Area of outstanding Natural Beauty and World Heritage Site, both in isolation and the extent to which it does/does not impact on views to the moor. If that is not possible that it be determined in line with their comments. This response represents the opinion of members of Linkinhorne Parish Council identified through a consultation process as per the Council emergency scheme of delegation and will be ratified at the next appropriate meeting of the council.

Following Linkinhorne Parish Council's response to the 5 day Protocol for Local Councils it was agreed (via the emergency scheme of delegation) to maintain the Council's original position on the proposal and requests that application PA21/01703 Land North of Gospenheal, Upton Cross, should be determined by the Planning Committee. The Clerk was informed by the planning officer on the 3rd of August that it had been decided that planning application PA21/01703 will be taken to the East Planning Committee, to be considered at the meeting provisionally arranged for 4th October 2021.

Decisions received from Cornwall Council:

- PA21/05908 Decided not to make a TPO (TCA apps) Barnacre Rilla Mill. Works to trees in a Conservation Area, namely remove Leylandii Cypress (T1)
- PA21/07041 Decided not to make a TPO (TCA apps). Cheesewring Farm, Minions. Work to trees in a Conservation Area, namely fell 3 large Spruce (T1, T4, & T6) due to damage to old Cornish wall.

Play areas

The weekly play inspections were received by the Clerk. Work has been undertaken on the entrance gate into the play area from the Parish Hall. The drain has been cleared by Cornwall Council and this should now

prevent flooding of the field along the footpath. The Gazebo has been repaired by a member of the council.
